

Llanthony Valley and District Show
Hedging Match & Stone Walling Competition

Rules

1. Competitors must be on the site by 9am when the draw will be made
2. Chain saws: any person using a chain saw must have a NPTC chain saw certificate with them and wear the relevant protective clothing at all times.
3. All competitors must wear safety hat and suitable footwear.
4. All rubbish to be deposited inside the field.
5. Each competitor to ditch, stake, pleach and heather the stated length in the allocated time.
6. Any competitor starting to fence must complete even if after the allocated time.
7. No competitors to cut turf more than 4 feet from his stake.
8. The Society will not hold itself responsible for any deviation from the schedule owing to weather conditions or other circumstances.
9. All disputes will be settled by the Committee whose decision will be final.
10. Any objection to be handed to the Secretary in writing within half an hour of the event with a deposit of £5, which will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
11. The Committee shall have the power to appoint other judges in place of those not able to act.
12. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor at any time or for any reason it deems sufficient.
13. The judges' decision is final.
14. The Committee reserves the right to alter or omit any part of the programme.
15. 'Local' means Capel-y-Ffin, Llanthony, Cwmyoy, Fforest Coalpit, Pandy, Longtown, Walterstone, Llanfihangel Crucorney, Llanbedr.
16. The Society will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage to any person, animal or property.
